

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the general public that a **quorum of the Arizona Game and Fish Commission** may attend and participate in the 13th Annual State Employee Charitable Campaign (SECC) Clay Target Fun Shoot, to be held on **Monday, November 15, 2010, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., at the Ben Avery Shooting Facility, Clay Target Center, 4044 W. Black Canyon Blvd (West of I-17 off Carefree Highway), Phoenix, Arizona 85086.**

The purpose of this event is to raise funds for the SECC. The Commission will take no legal action. The Commission will not discuss or deliberate on any matter reasonably anticipated to come before the Commission for legal action.

The Arizona Game and Fish Department is responsible for managing Arizona's fish and wildlife resource as an enduring public trust. In addition, the Department is charged with promoting safe and responsible use of watercraft and off-highway vehicles. Funding is provided from the sale of licenses and permits; watercraft registration fees; federal excise taxes on firearms, fishing equipment, boats, and other sporting goods; State lottery revenues; donations on State income tax forms; and various contracts and grants. Department policy is set by the Arizona Game and Fish Commission, whose five members are appointed by the Governor.
