The Ben Avery Shooting Facility corporate events are hosted Mondays, Tuesdays and Sundays and require a minimum of 10 employees with a maximum of 25. Once you've selected from the following options, please call the Ben Avery Shooting Facility at (623) 582-8313 to schedule your event.

Option #1: .22-caliber handgun

Package includes:

- Classroom instruction on firearms safety, fundamentals and marksmanship principles
- Eye and ear protection for use while on the firing line
- Use of either revolver or semi-automatic firearms
- 50 rounds of ammunition per participant
- Targets to take home as souvenirs

Cost: \$28 per shooter and a one-time range fee of \$50

Due to the amount of time available, groups will be encouraged to choose either revolver or semi-automatic firearms for their time on the range. The number of participants and how long it takes people to shoot handgun targets at distances of 5, 10 and 15 yards will determine actual range time.

Option #2: Indoor archery

Package includes:

- Classroom instruction on safety and shooting fundamentals
- 45 minutes to an hour of indoor range time
- Bows, arrows, paper targets and 3D targets (paper targets may be taken home as souvenirs)

Cost: \$28 per shooter and a one-time range fee of \$50

Due to time allowed, no minimum number of arrows will be established. The number of participants and how much they shoot will determine how many targets are used.

Option #3: Indoor air rifle

Package includes:

- Classroom instruction on safety and shooting fundamentals
- 45 minutes to an hour of indoor range time
- Rifles, pellets, targets and eye protection (targets may be taken home as souvenirs)

Cost: \$28 per shooter and a one-time range fee of \$50

Targets will be engaged at 10 meters from benchrest or standing position. Due to time allowed, no minimum number of pellets will be established. The number of participants and how much they shoot will determine how many targets are used.

Option #4: Combination of all three options

Participants will be divided into smaller groups and will spend approximately one hour at each shooting discipline. Groups will rotate to the different disciplines listed above. Up to 36 participants can be accommodated for this option.

Cost: \$35 per shooter and a one-time range fee of \$100.

Photo opportunities are available at all events if participants bring their own cameras.
