### Arizona Scholastic Clay Target Program (SCTP) How to Join the NGBs

To participate in the Commissioner's Cup State Championships you must be a member of the respective National Governing Body (NGB). For trap the Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA), for skeet the National Skeet Shooting Association (NSSA), for sporting clays the National Sporting Clays Association (NSCA). When you join an NGB they will send you a membership card with your NGB membership number. This number is used to report your scores to the NGB and must be submitted at or before the Commissioner's Cup to the shoot administrator. Your NGB number for an organization will remain the same, but you must renew your membership each year.

#### TRAP

You can join the ATA by calling Shawna Johnson of the ATA at 937-898-4638 Ext:525 or by visiting their website at [www.shootata.com](http://www.shootata.com) and selecting "Membership" from the menu on the left of the screen. The ATA target year is September 1 though August 31. You may join at any time during the season but everyone's membership will expire August 31. Junior (a shooter who has not reached his or her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday) and Sub Junior shooters (a shooter who has not reached his or her 15<sup>th</sup> birthday) can join the ATA for \$12 annually. Besides being necessary to compete in the state championship ATA membership will allow you to compete at registered trap events at trap ranges across the state and the US.

#### SKEET

You can join the NSSA by visiting their website at [www.mynssa.com](http://www.mynssa.com), highlighting "Membership" from the menu on the left of the screen and selecting "Online Enrollment / Renewal Form." Or you can download a paper application and mail it in by highlighting "Membership" on the left side of the screen and then selecting "Print Enrollment Form." The NSSA target year is November 1 to October 31. You may join at any time during the season but everyone's membership will expire October 31. Junior membership for SCTP participants is \$20. This includes subscription to the NSSA's official magazine the "Skeet Shooting Review." NSSA and NSCA also offer the Crossfire program where by joining NSSA you receive free membership in the NSCA. Besides being necessary to compete in the state championship NSSA membership will allow you to compete at registered skeet events at skeet ranges across the state and the US.

#### SPORTING CLAYS

You can join the NSCA by visiting their website at [www.mynsca.com](http://www.mynsca.com), highlighting "Membership" from the menu on the left of the screen and selecting "Individual Enrollment Form." Or you can download a paper application and mail it in by selecting "Forms" on the left side of the screen and then selecting "Membership Application" under Club and Member Forms. The NSSA target year is January 1 to December 31. You may join at any time during the season but everyone's membership will expire December 31. Junior membership for SCTP participants is \$20. This includes subscription to the NSCA's official magazine "Sporting Clays." NSCA and NSSA also offer the Crossfire program where by joining NSCA you receive free membership in NSSA. Besides being necessary to compete in the state championship NSCA membership will allow you to compete at registered clay events at clay courses across the state and the US.
