

JAGUAR CONSERVATION TEAM: ADDITIONAL SIGNATORIES TO THE  
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE ARIZONA GAME AND FISH DEPARTMENT  
AND THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH FOR JAGUAR CONSERVATION

Updated: February 20, 2009

On March 22, 2007, the Arizona Game and Fish Department and the New Mexico Department of Game and Fish executed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) as Lead Agencies for a state-led jaguar (*Panthera onca*) conservation program. The MOU provided for certain other government agencies to become signatory Cooperators on their written request and subsequent concurrence by both Lead Agencies and by concurrence (as indicated by voice vote) of a majority of the Cooperators present at a public meeting of the JAGCT where such requests are considered.
